First Rule: Remember to always keep the weekly Shabbat..

YEAR BEGINS: Thursday March 4, 2021

PASSOVER: March 17, 2021 (at evening)

UNLEAVENED BREAD: March 18-24

NOTE: (March 18 & March 24, are **HIGH SHABBATS**) No work on these two days..rest on these 2 days only..

2nd PASSOVER: If you missed the first Passover you must keep it in the second Month , April 16 at evening

2nd UNLEAVENED BREAD: April 17-23

(April 17 & 23 **High Shabbat**) rest on these 2 days only.. And also rest on the weekly Shabbat.

FEAST OF WEEKS: 9th May 2021.

Follow instructions on the first pdf that was sent to you with the calendar..

YEAR BEGINS: Thursday March 3, 2022

PASSOVER: March 16, 2022 (at evening)

UNLEAVENED BREAD: March 17-23, 2022

NOTE: (March 17 & March 23, are HIGH SHABBATS) No work on these two days..rest on these 2 days only..

2nd PASSOVER: If you missed the first Passover you must keep it in the second Month , April 15 at evening

UNLEAVENED BREAD: April 15-22, 2022

(April 15 & 22 High Shabbat) rest on these 2 days only.. And also rest on the weekly Shabbat.

FEAST OF WEEKS: 8th May 2022.

PASSOVER: March 15, 2023 (at evening)

UNLEAVENED BREAD: March 16-22, 2023

NOTE: (March 16 & March 22, are **HIGH SHABBATS**) No work on these two days..rest on these 2 days only..

2nd PASSOVER: If you missed the first Passover you must keep it in the second Month , April 14 at evening

UNLEAVENED BREAD: April 15-21, 2023

(April 15 & 21 **High Shabbat**) rest on these 2 days only.. And also rest on the weekly Shabbat.

FEAST OF WEEKS: 7th May 2023.

Follow instructions on the first pdf that was sent to you with the calendar..

NEW WAVE OFFERING: 25th of June 2023 (follow the instructions on the pdf with the calendar that I sent to you)

YOM TERUAH (Trumpet) August 31, 2023

SOLOMON'S DEDICATION: Sept 7-13, 2023

SUKKOT: Sept 14-21, 2023

High Shabbat on 2 days only (14 & 21 of sept, 2023... no work on those 2 days)

HANUKKAH: November 24-30, 2023

PURIM\LOTS: Feb 10-12, 2024..

FEAST DAYS, 2024

First Rule: Remember to always keep the weekly Shabbat..

YEAR BEGINS: Thursday Feb 29, 2024

PASSOVER: March 13, 2024 (at evening)

UNLEAVENED BREAD: March 14-21, 2024

NOTE: (March 14 & March 21, are **HIGH SHABBATS**) No work on these two days..rest on these 2 days only..

2nd PASSOVER: If you missed the first Passover you must keep it in the second Month , April 16 at evening

UNLEAVENED BREAD: April 12-29, 2024

(April 12 & 29 **High Shabbat**) rest on these 2 days only.. And also rest on the weekly Shabbat.

FEAST OF WEEKS: 5th May 2024.

Follow instructions on the first pdf that was sent to you with the calendar..

NEW WAVE OFFERING: 23th of June 2024 (follow the instructions on the pdf with the calendar that I sent to you)

YOM TERUAH (Trumpet) Sept 5, 2024

SOLOMON'S DEDICATION: Sept 12-18 2024

SUKKOT: Sept 19-26, 2024

High Shabbat on 2 days only (19 & 26 of sept, 2024... no work on those 2 days)

HANUKKAH: November 21-28

PURIMLOTS: Feb 8-10, 2025..

(Please follow the Calendar on the pdf I sent to you, and use it with the Gregorian Calendar, along.

If you are skill enough you don't have to use the Gregorian Calendar.. Just count your days, 364 days in a year only)..

The reason why I give you the start of the year, is because ***YAHs*** calendar is fixed, (and the Calendar will always start on a Thursday)..

The ***Passover*** is always in the middle of the week, Wednesday the 14 of ***Abib***, on our calendar. Then ***HaMashiach*** rose early on the first day of the week (called Sunday), on the 18th of ***Abib***..

***This Is the fixed calendar that will never be out of season*..**

When you print you copy.. You will get the fullness.. ***Shalom***..

Please make at least 2 hard copies, and always have a copy anywhere you go..
Be safe

Every year, ***Passover*** will fall in the middle of the week on a Wednesday..

So this ***Passover*** will fall on Wednesday March 17, 2021.

Please note.

(The Year always finishes on a Wednesday, the 4thday of the week),

(and will always starts on a Thursday the 5thday of the week).
